This winter we have been blessed to have fantastic weather for all of our members to enjoy our golf course. Our Ground Maintenance department has been hard at work with our winter works program that includes many items to improve our golf course in the upcoming year. These items include tree trimming, bunker renovations, drainage repairs, general landscape cleanup and ornamental tree planting

Our tree trimming program is designed to accomplish several goals. First, we strategically trim trees that are causing us shade issues on the golf course and restrict our ability to grow quality turf grass. Secondly, we have many beautiful Banyan and Lychee trees that are hidden from view. Our clean up and trimming program will highlight these trees and improve the overall beauty of our course.

We have completed our bunker renovation on holes 13, 15 and 25 in 2016 and you will see much more aesthetically pleasing bunkers which make the holes much more interesting as well as repairing the drainage and replacing the bunker liners. These bunkers will no longer hold water in heavy rains.

We are repairing drainage on holes 2, 7, 9, 16, 21, 22, 25. The poor drainage in these areas seriously impacted our ability to grow grass and will now drain much better in during heavy rains resulting in much better turf conditions.

As we discussed earlier, our clean-up program is intended to highlight our many beautiful trees in addition to making our golf course look much more detailed and clean. Another benefit to this program is that you will also be able to find your errant shots more often and get them back into play.
