

Driving Safety

Dear Members,

We hope this finds you well and look forward to seeing you at the club soon.

We have some recent issues concerning the driving of automobiles that wrong direction while going to the parking lot as well as golf cart accidents involving golfer's texting while driving their golf cart and running into the golf cart in front of them. I will address each of these issues below.

Concerning automobile driving direction, you will notice that we have very clearly marked directional arrows on the driveway directing you the proper direction, please adhere to this at all time. You will also notice that we have added poles that are changed in front of the landscaped triangle in order to separate traffic. (Please see photo) Please note that the 1-2 seconds that you may save by driving the wrong direction against the arrows are simply not worth the risk of an accident in which you endanger people and property. If you are in an accident and operating your auto in an unsafe manner or driving the wrong direction, you will be 100% liable for any problems that occur. The club reserves the right to disallow people and/or vehicles on our club property that are driven in an unsafe manner.

Concerning the operation of golf carts, texting or using your hand phone while the cart is moving, please be aware that you are endangering your fellow golfer, our staff as well as yourself. A golf cart hitting a person from behind may prove to result severe physical damage to that person or may even prove fatal. We must not allow this to happen and in the event it does, the driver of the golf cart is again, 100% liable for losses to person or property.

We have added to the cart steering wheel a notice that requires you not to use your hand phone. By driving this golf cart, you are accepting the rules on that steering wheel of the proper use of the vehicle. Our caddies have been instructed to politely remind you, if you must use your phone, to allow that caddie to drive. The caddies have the right to refuse service if they feel their safety is at risk.

We have one of the best clubs in Southern China that all of our members, your guests and our staff share. We are all proud of our club and I hope that you can receive this letter with the good intentions in which it is sent.
